### **Glera, Valdo Origine Spumante Brut, Veneto, Italy, 75cl**

Sweet fruit and apple on the palate and lots of bubbles. €45

### **Glera Prosecco, Porta Leone Marca Travigiana Bianco Frizzante, Veneto, Italy, 20cl**

This is a creamy frizzante sparkler with lots fresh fruit & sweet citrus aromas. €9.95

### **Platino Sparkling Brut, Penedes, Spain, 5%, NV**

Intense aromas of pear and citrus. Delicate bubbles offering a pleasant roundness with a crisp refreshing finish. **Low alcohol.** €30

## **Whites**

### **Chardonnay, Papparuda, Cramele Recas, Timisora, Romania, '18**

Ripe fruits of mango and a buttery tropical side to this full-bodied wine. €25, €6.50

### **Pinot Grigio, Zagalia Garganega, Cantine Minini, Sicily, Italy, '18**

Lovely fresh aromas of white and citrus fruits such as pears and green apples. €25.85, €6.60

### **Picpoul, Saint Peyre, Languedoc, France, '17**

Complex aromas of gooseberry and citrus flavours. Fresh and fruity on the palate with a long lingering finish. €29, €7.75

### **Gewurztraminer Riesling, Willowglen De Bortoli, Riverina, NSW, Australia, '18**

Perfumed aromatics of musk, spice and ripened citrus. Ideal with seafood, curries and spicy dishes. €31, €7.50



**Pinot Grigio Rose, San Giorgio, Veneto, Italy '18,**

Staff Favourite. One of the best Pinot Grigios available. Crisp, summer fruit driven pink with clean acidity and a refreshing finish. Candyfloss in a glass! €31, €7.50

**Falanghina, Janare del Sannio DOP, Campania, Italy '17,'18**

Highly recommended. 100% Falanghina. Straw yellow, characteristic fruity bouquet of good intensity. A balanced, pleasant and refreshing wine. €33.00

**Anta Vaz, Roupeiro, Perrum, Monte Velho, Herdade Do Esporao, Alentejano, Portugal, '17**

Medium bodied. A beautiful well balanced smooth white with soft fruits. €35

**Sauvignon Blanc, 3 Woolly Sheep, Lawson's Dry Hills, Marlborough, NZ, '18**

Classic Marlborough aromas of citrus and limes with elderflower and grapefruit. A standout NZ Sauvignon Blanc. €40, €10.50

**Grüner Veltliner 'Crazy Creatures', Malat, Kremstal, Austria, '17, '18**

Fresh, crisp custard apple the perfect balance of fruit and alcohol. A must try fruit bomb! €39.00

**Chardonnay, Petit Chablis, Alain Geoffroy, Burgundy, France, '18**

This comes from 20 year old vines grown on Kimmeridgian limestone. It is lively, pleasant and fruity. Lovely citrus flavours on a fine, minerally background, €45.00



## **Reds**

**Pinot Noir, Cramele Racas, Paparuda, Timisora, Romania, '18**

Dark and rich with layers of complex black cherry, raspberry and cinnamon. €25, €6.50

**Merlot, La Chaise, Languedoc Roussillon, France, '17**

Delicious juicy plummy fruits with mocha and herbaceous notes. €26.50

**Montepulciano, Zagalia, Cantine Minini, Abruzzo, Italy, '17**

A young wine full of juicy blackberry and cherry fruits. It has a lovely touch of spice on the finish. €27, €7

**Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Franc, Chateau Camarsan, Bordeaux, France, '16,'18**

This wine displays beautiful and bright dark purple colour. The nose reveals aromas of black and red fruits with an intense finish. €30, €7.50

**Merlot, Domaine Sant Maurici, Narbonne, Languedoc, France, '16**

Well-balanced with scents of wild berries. Soft and elegant finish. €31

**Shiraz, Deen De Bortoli, Vat 8, NSW & Victoria, Australia, '15, '16**

A Family Favourite. A robust wine with a rich bouquet of blackberries and plums with spicy notes. The palate has soft fine-grained tannins, peppery oak and a hint of black. €35, €9



***Rioja Crianza, Bodegas Valdemar, Finca del Marquesado, Rioja Reserve, Nth Spain, '15***

Highly recommended classic Reserve. Garnet red colour with purple hues, clear and bright. A very rounded, well-balanced wine with a full, long aftertaste. €39, €10

***Oludeo, La Soñadora, Yecla, Spain (by Kildare winemaker Simon Tyrrell), '16***

Highly recommended. Made from 100% hand harvested Monastrell, fermented in stainless steel and aged for 10 months in French oak. Medium bodied with brambly fruit characters and a long, fresh finish. €35

***Valpolicella Ripasso Tenuta Lena Di Mezz, Ca' Rugate, Valpolicella, Italy, '16***

Dark purple ruby colour. Cherry, plum, liquorice and spices on the nose. Plenty of dried fruit on the palate with an excellent finish. €48



## Beers & Ciders

Locally sourced, locally owned as best we can – that's the plan!

**GFA (Gluten Free Ale) / 500ml / 4.8% / England / €6.50**  
Lovely fruit and citrus finish. An outstanding beer with everything but the gluten!!

**Longways Medium Dry Cider, 4.5% / Carrick on Suir, Co. Tipp, about 100kms away. 500ml / €6.50.**  
Award winning handmade dry slightly sweet cider made with bittersweet apples.

**Longways Elderflower Cider / 4.5% / €6.50**  
A delicate sweet cider made with Sweet Katie apples infused with wild elderflower.

**Black Donkey – Sheep Stealer / 5.6% / Ballinalough, Co Roscommon, 65 kms from here / €6.50**

Kin Khao's favourite local brewer! A traditional Saison beer. Dry, crisp and with complex aromas.

**Black Donkey – Buck It / 4.8% / €6.50**

A malty hybrid amber ale. Irish malt, Belgian specialty malts and American hops and yeast.

**Black Donkey – Scythe / 4.6% / €6.50**

Traditional Belgian pale ale at its best. Irish malt, Belgian specialty malts and American hops and yeast.

**Carrig Brewing - Carrig Pilsner, 4.8% / Drumshanbo, Co Leitrim, 74kms from here / €6.00**

Peppery Saaz hops balance the subtle sweet malty character of this beautiful Pilsner.

**Carrig Brewing - Poachers Pale Ale / 4.7%/500ml/ €6.00**

A classic pale ale with Chinook and Cascade hops giving a lovely floral flavour in this classic American Pale Ale.

**Carrig Brewing – Coalface IPA, 5.5%/500ml/€6.00**

Pours like stout but it's not. Chocolate and toffee with grapefruit bitterness. We adore this one☺
